August Do 1 Thing...Connecting with Community

The Goal: Make your community stronger by getting trained and getting involved.

- Get CERT (Community Emergency Response Team) or other emergency training. The City of Novi now has 76 residents that have completed 24 hours of CERT training and a mock disaster exercise.
- o Attend a Neighborhood Watch or Neighborhood Association Meeting (ours is September 27.)
- o Connect with an isolated individual in your neighborhood
- o Become a volunteer in your community
- Host a neighborhood get together

DID YOU KNOW?

In the event of an emergency, a city hotline will be activated. Call (248) 735-5680. The phone line will be used only during an emergency and will keep community members apprised of any pertinent information.

When necessary, Emergency Relief Centers will be set up in the city. Ours is located at Village Oaks Elementary.
