

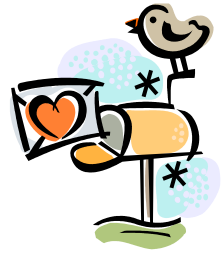

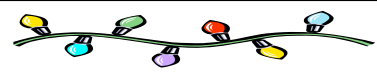

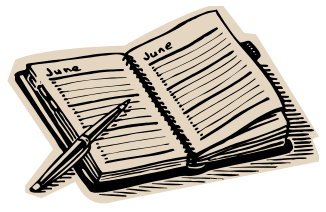

February Do 1 Thing...Water



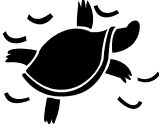
This month, store 72 hours (3 days) worth of water in case the local water supply is temporarily contaminated.
