CALENDAR CORNER

- ✓ Yard waste pickup resumes on April 10 (Friday of the first full week in April).
- ✓ The annual invoice for dues and trash collection fees will be mailed April 30. Payment is due by May 31st. Your prompt payment makes life a lot easier for our treasurer, not to mention saving you late fees, which will be assessed on June 1 (\$25), with another \$25 assessed if payment is still outstanding on July 1. Things get worse from there, so please, contact Carol Spellman if you need to make payment arrangements.
- ✓ Inside that mailing will be your brand new 2009 Turtle Creek directory. Please take a moment to ensure your entry is correct; if not, please contact Walt Spellman so we can be sure to get it right next time, and make any necessary corrections to the address labels we use throughout the year.
- ✓ The annual subdivision garage sale will be held Friday, May 15 -Saturday, May 16 from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
- ✓ Expect pavement and bridge repair work to affect your commute. 8 bridge repairs and some repaving will occur in the stretch of I-96/I-696 between Beck and Halstead roads. Of key impact: ramps from Novi Road onto eastbound I-696 will close from April 14 through October. Repavement projects have been also been approved for the stretch of Nine Mile Road between Meadowbrook and Haggerty; Meadowbrook Road between Eight Mile and Nine Mile Roads; Nine Mile between Taft and Novi Road; and Novi Road, I-96 to 12 Mile Road. 
WORD FROM THE BEAT ON OUR STREETS...
