Do you know that . . . you can place **ALL** these items in your recycling bin! No need to separate!

- ✓ Glass (empty, clean containers and jars)
- ✓ Plastic Jugs/Bottles (#1, #2, up to 1 gallon)
- ✓ Household Plastic (#3 - #7, empties only)
- ✓ Plastic Bags (most retail & grocery bags)
- ✓ Aluminum Cans (empty cans only)
- ✓ Steel & Tin Cans (empty cans only)
- ✓ Paper (junk mail, office paper, magazines, catalogs, bagged or bundled newspaper)
- ✓ Paperboard (no wax coated paperboard)
- ✓ Cardboard (flatten and cut into pieces no larger than 2'x2') & Paper Bags
