Dates to Keep in Mind

- Novi Dog Park will open on Saturday, October 18. Conveniently located just south of the Ten Mile and Novi Road intersection behind the Novi Ice Arena. Please check http://www.cityofnovi.org.
- City-recommended hours for Halloween trick or treating are from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Friday, October 31st
- Daylight Saving Time ends on Sunday, November 2nd. Set your clocks BACK one hour. This is a great time to change the batteries in your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors!
- ✓ Vote on Tuesday, November 4th

- ✓ Last day for yard waste pickup is Saturday, November 29th (delayed one day due to Thanksgiving holiday). Remember to cut long items into 4-foot bundles and tie them up.

Be considerate of your neighbors and do not put trash out for pick-up until the night before. City ordinances allow trash to be set at the curb no more than 24 hours prior to pick-up.
