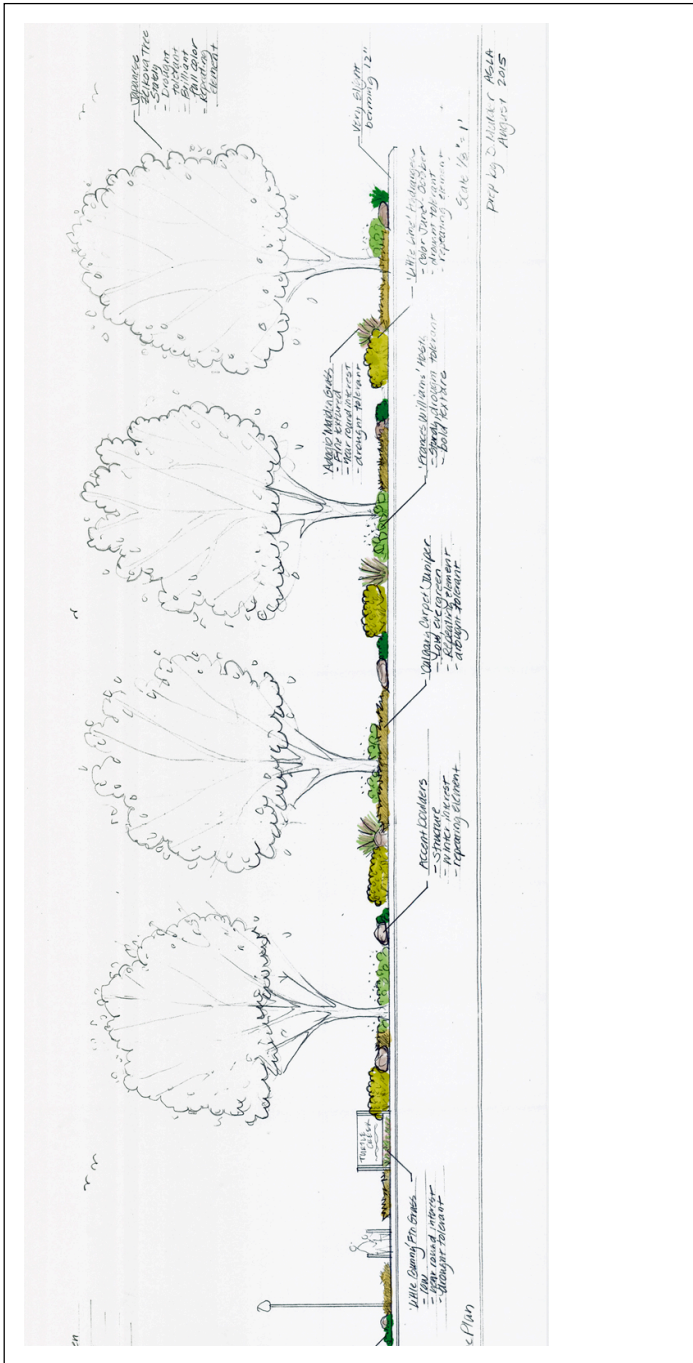

Dates to Keep in Mind

- ✓ City-recommended hours for Halloween trick or treating are from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm on Saturday, October 31st
- ✓ Daylight Saving Time ends on Sunday, November 1st. Set your clocks BACK one hour. This is a great time to change the batteries in your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors too!
- ✓ Last day for yard waste pickup is Saturday, November 28th (delayed one day due to Thanksgiving holiday). Remember to cut long items into 4-foot bundles and tie them up.

Be considerate of your neighbors and do not put trash out for pick-up until the night before. City ordinances allow trash to be set at the curb no more than 24 hours prior to pick-up.

Safety First

Please ensure that homes and vehicles are locked and secure at all times. Do not leave valuables in vehicles when not attended. Please also have outdoor lights on at night.
