The Goals

1. Develop a simple yet beautiful design.
2. Highlight the 'creek' theme through incorporation of a winding dry river bed.
3. Create an underlying structure with shade trees, evergreen shrubs and boulders.
4. Provide seasonal interest with flowering bulbs, perennials, ornamental grasses and shrubs.
5. Incorporate unity through mass plantings and repeating plant groupings.
6. Facilitate sustainability through the use of drought tolerant plants.
