# **City of Novi Trash Collection Update**

As you may have heard, the City of Novi is in the process of contracting with a single trash hauler for the city as a whole starting this summer.

As of April 1, the current status of this process is:

- 1. Bids were received Feb. 19, 2016
- 2. <u>City Council to discuss and vote</u> on May 23, 2016
- 3. <u>Potential</u> start of service is scheduled for July 2016

When this goes into effect trash collection in the City of Novi will no longer be allowed by separate vendors, starting tentatively on July 1, 2016.

Residents will be billed on their tax bills in a separate line item for trash collection services. These services will be very similar to what is now provided in Turtle Creek by Duncan Disposal. Any issues with collection will be handled directly by the City of Novi.

### What does this mean for Turtle Creek?

Turtle Creek currently has a contract with Duncan Disposal until June 30, 2017. As such, the City of Novi **MUST** honor this contract.

Turtle Creek will be billing our residents in May for HOA dues as well as for the coming year trash collection. **These fees are due by May 31, 2016.** 

Residents **will not** have the option of skipping payment of the trash collection fee in favor of contracting on their own with another hauler. The choice is to **utilize the subdivision hauler or have no trash service.** 

Residents not paying the trash collection fee by the due date will have their name removed from the pick-up list this year and will have no alternative. In the past we have had homeowners stretch out dues/fee payments for 6 months. This will not be allowed this year as we will be in the last year of our contract.

# **Entrance Island Landscaping Update**

The Novi City Council awarded Turtle Creek \$5,000 toward our Entrance Island Landscaping Project at their April 4, 2016 meeting!

This award was recommended by the Novi Beautification Commission in March. Congratulations and *"thank you"* to the Turtle Creek Landscaping Committee for preparing the grant application and presenting our plan for new entrance island landscaping to the Commission.

Our project is moving into high gear. In the coming weeks you can expect to see the following happening at both islands:

- Replacement of the large public light fixture with an attractive dual-light LED residential fixture
- Removal of existing trees, shrubs and landscape rock; extraction of old sign posts and concrete footings
- Installation of new sign posts; signs will be placed closer to the main road to improve visibility
- Installation of new LED lighting for the signs

Our landscape designer, Mulder Design Group, is actively sourcing our new trees and shrubs. Weather permitting, we hope to have our beautiful landscaping installed in May.

Please be assured we are doing all we can to get the work completed expeditiously. Your patience and continued support of this project are greatly appreciated as crews go about their work!

#### **Neighborhood Reminders**

- Springtime brings outdoor activities. Please observe speed limits in the subdivision to keep neighbors safe!
- Please leave your porch lights on at night for safety.
- Do not leave cars on the street overnight to avoid potential theft or damage.
- Recreational vehicles & trailers cannot be stored in your driveway unless you are packing/unpacking for a trip.
- Please keep pets on a leash while walking through the subdivision and clean up after them when needed.

# Protect Your Family from Mosquitoes – Tips from Oakland County and the City of Novi

- Use Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)-registered insect repellant. All EPA-registered insect repellants are evaluated for safety and effectiveness. Always follow the product label instructions carefully, especially when applying insect repellant on children. **Do not use insect repellant on babies younger than 2 months of age.**
- Wear protective clothing such as long-sleeved shirts and pants.
- Avoid outdoor activities during daylight for about two hours after sunrise and several hours before sunset. Protect yourself from mosquito bites at night in well-lit areas.
- Maintain window and door screens to keep mosquitoes out of buildings. Do not prop open doors.
- Get rid of mosquito breeding sites by removing standing water in and around your home. Once a week, empty and scrub, turn over, cover, or throw out items that hold water: buckets, toys, pools, birdbaths, flowerpots, etc.
- Look for non-toxic mosquito control options to rid your yard of mosquitoes without harming beneficial insects.
