- ✓ **Household Hazardous Waste drop-off** will take place at the Novi Civic Center, 45175 W. Ten Mile Rd., on Saturday, October 6 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Electronic waste recycling and paper shredding are available at this event. See www.RRRASOC.org for details.
- ✓ **Halloween** is Wednesday, October 31. City-recommended hours for **trick or treating** are 6-8 p.m. For Halloween safety tips, visit www.cityofnovi.org, click on the *Public Safety* link and follow *Police>Administration>A Message from the Chief*.
- ✓ **Daylight Saving Time ends** on Sunday, November 4. Set your clocks **BACK** one hour. Remember to change the batteries in your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors too!
- ✓ **Last yard waste pickup is Friday, November 30.** Contact Waste Management (866.797.9018) for questions regarding trash pickup service, or visit www.cityofnovi.org and click on the *Quick Link for Trash Collection*. Please be considerate of your neighbors and do not put trash out for pick-up until the night before.

This saves the association mailing costs, and gives residents timely information.
